When We SHOULD Divide

Occasions to divide...

- A Different Jesus (1 John 2:18-23; 2 John 7-11)
- A Different Gospel (Galatians 1:6-9; Revelation 1:8-9)
- An Abuse of Grace (Matthew 18:15-17; 1 Corinthians 5; Jude 3-7)
- A Conflict-ridden Character (**Titus 3:10; 3 John 9-11; Jude 16**) *Two kinds of judging...*
 - 1. Honest assessment, discernment, and disagreement.
 - 2. God-like prosecution/condemnation over someone's inner self.

To Judge or Not to Judge

Steps to Loving More and Judging Less...

Matthew 7:1-6

- 1. RETHINK your position (vv 1-2)
- 2. REFLECT on your own condition (v 3)
- 3. REASON/Motivation is caregiving, not ego energizing (v. 4)
- 4. REPENT of your own sin first, including your judgmentalism (v. 5)
- 5. RESPOND to their need. (v.5)
